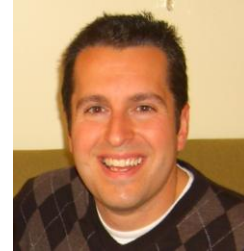
Candidate's Night

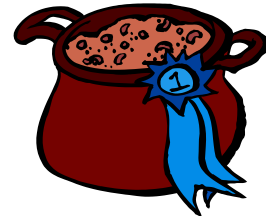

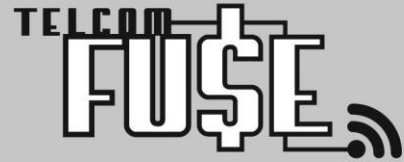
